### PLEASE - READ ME FIRST Installation instructions for the PANAVEX mirror

Thank you for purchasing the PANAVEX mirror for your vehicle. Since 1985, PANAVEX Products has been providing this simple and economical accessory for discriminating drivers. After just a few days, many have wondered how they ever got along without it!

Installation takes just a few minutes, however to ensure a proper fit and adhesion, please read through this sheet before attempting to install the mirror on your vehicle. NOTE: The pressure sensitive tape bonds instantly on contact offering NO opportunity for a second attempt or removal without possible damage to the factory or PANAVEX mirrors.

On some vehicles, PANAVEX mirrors are made for left and right applications. They are not interchangeable due to the convex radius. Confirm you have received the correct version for your application. IF YOU HAVE ANY QUESTIONS CONTACT US OR YOUR SUPPLIER BEFORE CONTINUING THE INSTALLATION OF THE PANAVEX MIRROR.

#### Step 1: Check size & shape



Apply the supplied suction cup to the front of the PANAVEX mirror for ease of handling and installation. DO NOT REMOVE THE GREEN PROTECTIVE STRIP AT THIS TIME. Check the size and shape against the original factory mirror. The PANAVEX mirror should cover the original mirror completely and closely conform to it's shape.

# Step 3 Remove strip - apply mirror



Remove the green protective strip from the back of the PANAVEX mirror, and carefully apply it to the factory mirror. Avoid touching the adhesive tape. DO NOT EXERT EXCESSIVE PRESSURE TO THE CENTER OF THE PANAVEX MIRROR AS THIS WILL CAUSE IT TO BREAK. It is normal for a small gap to exist between the center of the PANAVEX mirror and the factory mirror.

### Step 2: Clean the factory mirror



Clean the factory mirror with a conventional glass cleaner, removing all residual grease, tar, and dirt. Any residue might result in a less than perfect bond between the PANAVEX and factory mirrors. This is good time to try a few "Dry" runs of applying the PANAVEX mirror. In step 3 you will only get one opportunity to get it right!

## Step 4 Apply pressure to edges



Apply a small amount of pressure at the extreme right and left edges of the PANAVEX mirror. **Do not apply pressure to center**, the small gap provides for expansion and contraction between the two mirrors. The adhesive tape bonds instantly, however it will become stronger over the next days. You are ready to go!
